

BRUSH CHIPPER SAFETY

STAY ALERT, WATCH WHAT YOU ARE DOING AND USE COMMON SENSE WHEN OPERATING. IF YOU DO NOT UNDERSTAND THE SAFE OPERATION OF THE EQUIPMENT, STOP WHAT YOU ARE DOING!!! CALL US IMMEDIATELY!!!

- 1) Always inspect the machine before each use. Do not use if part are missing or broken.
- 2) Wear a hard hat, safety glasses, close-fitting gloves and clothing, and hearing protection.
- 3) Block tires before operating. Use on a firm level surface.
- 4) Make sure there are no obstructions in the intake chute before starting the engine.
- 5) Point the discharge in a safe direction, away from people and buildings.
- 6) Never operate the chipper alone.
- 7) Keep hands and feet out of the intake chute while the chipper is running.
- 8) Feed brush into chipper butt-end first.
- 9) Never smoke or use any type of open flame near the chipper.
- 10) Never stand or walk in front of the discharge chute while the engine is running.

Understanding the capacities and limitations of the chipper are important for operator safety. If you are in doubt as to the safe operation of this equipment,
