



CUT-OFF SAW SAFETY

**STAY ALERT, WATCH WHAT YOU ARE DOING AND USE COMMON SENSE WHEN OPERATING. IF YOU DO NOT UNDERSTAND THE SAFE OPERATION OF THE EQUIPMENT, STOP WHAT YOU ARE DOING!!!

- 1) Wear hard-hat, safety glasses, hearing protection, and breathing mask or respirator.
- 2) Most cutting produces sparks. Fill the gas tank in a well-ventilated area on a bare surface at least 10 feet away from the cutting area. Wipe up any spilled fuel thoroughly.
- 3) When starting, the operator should be at least 10 feet from where the saw was fuelled.
- 4) Only use blades of the right diameter and arbour size, intended for high-speed, hand-held saws.
