**KNOWING A MACHINE'S CAPABILITIES AND PROPER OPERATION IS KEY TO SAFE OPERATION. IF YOU ARE UNSURE AS TO THE SAFE OPERATION OF THE UNIT YOU ARE OPERATING, STOP WHAT YOU ARE DOING!!!
CONTACT US IMMEDIATELY!!!**

- 1) Always call before digging!
- 2) Always wear a seat belt for restraint.
- 3) Never use loader without operator cab with ROPS approval.
- 4) Never exceed the machines rated operator capacity.
- 5) Never use loader as a man lift or elevating device for personnel.
- 6) If you must work in an enclosed area, make sure there is adequate ventilation.
- 7) Never carry riders. Keep bystanders away from work area.
- 8) Always carry bucket or attachments as low as possible. Do not travel or turn with lift arms up. Load, unload, and turn on flat level ground.
- 9) Never leave the loader with the engine running or with lift arms up. To park, engage parking brake and put attachment flat on the ground.
