



TRAILER SAFETY

ALWAYS DOUBLE CHECK THE LOAD AND TRAILER HOOKUP BEFORE PULLING A TRAILER. KNOW THE CAPACITIES AND LIMITATIONS OF THE TRAILER AND TOW VEHICLE. IF YOU ARE IN DOUBT AS TO THE SAFE OPERATION AND TIE-DOWN OF YOUR LOAD, CALL US IMMEDIATELY!!!

- 1) Make sure the tow vehicle is rated to pull the trailer you intend to use.
- 2) Make sure the trailer coupler and towing coupler are the same size and proper capacity.
- 3) The trailer must be connected to the tow vehicle before loading or unloading.
- 4) Attach safety chains, making sure you cross them.
- 5) Check for proper tire pressure.
- 6) Check all lighting on trailer and tow vehicle.
- 7) After traveling a short distance, stop to make sure that the load is secure, and that all tie-downs are tight.
- 8) Allow for greater braking distance when towing; generally travel at slower speeds.
